CIS Social November 8th 3-5 pm



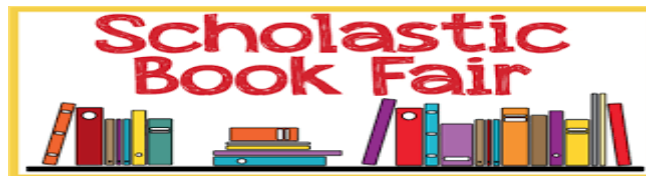
