1st 9 Weeks--Supplies needed for remote learning:

- Earbuds/headphones—will be used for all subjects
- 1 pack of loose leaf paper
- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Highlighters
- Pencils (mechanical and regular)
- 1 box of colored pencils
- 1 small box of crayons
- Hand held sharpener for colored pencils
- Pocket folders: 1 each for Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, and Math
- *Language Arts*: 1 subject spiral notebook
- *Math*: 5 subject notebook
- *Science*: 3 subject notebook

*****The above items will need to be sent in to school when we transition back to face to face learning since students will continue using these items in our classrooms.***

Additional supplies needed when we transition to face to face instruction:

Students will need one binder to keep all materials in. A zippered binder is preferred (*Trapper Keeper, Case It, etc.*), but a regular 3 ring binder approximately 2 inches in size would be acceptable. This one binder will be divided so that all subjects can be kept inside. **Students will use this one binder for all classes throughout the day. Inside the binder, they will put their pocket folders, loose leaf paper, and spiral notebooks that were used during remote learning so that they can continue using them for face to face instruction.**

*****Also needed:***

- 1 pack of graph paper for Math
- 1 marbled composition notebook for Language Arts
- Plenty of loose leaf paper
- 1 black fine point Sharpie
- Plastic pencil box or pencil pouch (to store students' supplies during the day)

*****For the Homeroom teacher only, each student needs to bring:***

- Kleenex
- Paper towels
- Liquid hand soap
- Box of Ziplock bags (quart or gallon size)
- 1 pack of copy paper
- 1 pack of card stock paper

*****Requested items (for homeroom teacher)— if able to donate:***

- Hand sanitizer
- Clorox wipes

*****Optional items:***

- Tennis balls , Dry erase (Expo) markers
- Items for outside recess(soccer balls, volleyballs, footballs, jump ropes, etc.) and for inside recess(board games, card games, etc.)
