



Camden County Schools' Student Technology Responsible Use Agreement

The use of school system technological resources, including access to the Internet, is a privilege, not a right. Individual users of the school system's technological resources are responsible for their behavior and communications when using those resources. Responsible use of school system technological resources is use that is ethical, respectful, academically honest, and supportive of student learning. Each user has the responsibility to respect others in the school community and on the Internet. General student and employee behavior standards, including those prescribed in applicable board policies, the Code of Student Conduct, and other regulations and school rules, apply to use of the Internet and other school technological resources. In addition, anyone who uses school system computers or electronic devices or who accesses the school network or the Internet using school system resources must comply with the additional rules for responsible use listed below. These rules are intended to clarify expectations for conduct but should not be construed as all-inclusive.

Before using school system technological resources, students and employees must sign a statement indicating that they understand and will strictly comply with these requirements and acknowledging awareness that the school system uses monitoring systems to monitor and detect inappropriate use of technological resources and tracking systems to track and recover lost or stolen equipment.

I hereby agree to strictly comply with the terms and conditions of Camden County Schools' Board Policy Code:

3225/4312/7320 Technology Responsible Use and all other policies as referenced therein. Failure to adhere to the requirements listed in the Technology Responsible Use Policy will result in disciplinary action, including revocation of user privileges. Willful misuse may result in disciplinary action and/or criminal prosecution under applicable state and federal law.

I further agree to be responsible for any school technology equipment or device that I am allowed to use. **I have also received a copy of the Parent/Student 1:1 Chromebook Classroom Initiative Handbook and agree to the terms.** I will promptly report any issues with or damage to the device to my teacher, understanding that I may be financially responsible for any damages as outlined in board policy

I grant permission for my child to have independent access to the Internet, to monitoring of the student's Internet activity and e-mail communication by school personnel, and to create any accounts in third party systems for school related projects designed to assist students in mastering effective and proper online communications or to meet other educational goals.

I understand that I am granting this permission and will strictly comply with the terms of the Technology Responsible Use Agreement as outlined in the board policy for my child who is a student in the Camden County Schools' system, unless revoked by me in writing to the school principal of the school in which my child attends any time during the school year. I also understand and acknowledge that the school system uses monitoring systems to detect inappropriate use of technological resources.
